Childcare Resources Thompson, Okanagan, and Kootenays

The Refugee Response Fund is a provincially funded-program that supports services and programs for resettled refugees from Afghanistan and displaced Ukrainians arriving in Canada under the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel program.

The Refugee Response Team, Thompson, Okanagan and Kootenays is compiled of six multi-service agencies, including Columbia Basin Alliance for Literacy, Kamloops Immigrant Services, KCR Community Resources, Shuswap Immigrant Services Society, South Okanagan Immigrant and Community Services, and Vernon and District Immigrant and Community Services Society.

The team has compiled a list of childcare resources in the Thompson, Okanagan, and Kootenay regions. These include summer camps, day care, after-school care, and preschool services. The information is listed alphabetically by provider name. Ages for eligibility are listed in the second-last column on the right.
