We are Jamie and Matt and we are a fun, love-filled family of five (three humans and two dogs), looking to add another family member through adoption.

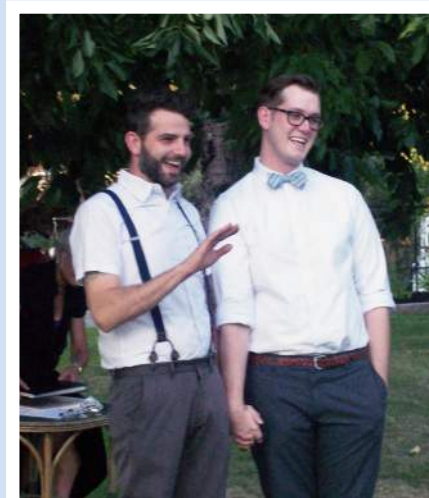
We met in the summer of 2009, and were married in 2012. Our wedding was a casual backyard event at Matt's family home with all of our friends and family.

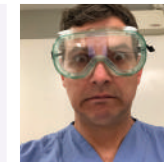
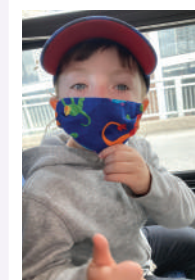
