## **Adopting from South Africa**

I had the honor to meet with Gordon Lewis (ED of Mission of Tears) and Robyn Shepstone, the South African social worker who is working with Mission of Tears in South Africa in Edmonton recently on October 5, 2014 to learn more about this exciting new adoption program available to BC'ers through the Adoption Centre of BC. Rev. Lewis and Ms. Shepstone clearly outlined the process to adopt from South Africa leaving me with the impression that this is a very exciting program for a number of different reasons: 1) the children available are relatively young and; 2) wait times at this point are very short in the realm of intercountry adoptions and; 3) Criteria for adopting are not overly prohibitive for BCer's!

Despite some bad press from years ago the prospects of adopting from South Africa appear to be better than ever! Here are some of the details:

#### Children Available:

The majority of children are from 8 months of age and older. The majority of the children are male. All children are of black African heritage.

South African Criteria for adoption:

Couples must be married a minimum of 2 years; Have a minimum of high school education; Have a sound financial portfolio; At least one is a Canadian Citizen; Not divorced more than once per spouse.

There must be a minimum of 18 months between the youngest child and the adopted child and the newly adopted child cannot be older than the previous child in the home.
